<b>UNIQUE LOCAL CONDITIONS</b>	Subject to special circumstances teams may apply for an allowance that either provides additional total points or reduces the individual player quota subject to the circumstances and club's recent history.	1. Small Population Base or Low Urban Engagement area	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Additional points to team allocations where the club is in an area with lower population base than regional centre in same competition or has low urban engagement compared to other suburbs in same competition.</li> <li>• Additional points to team allocation where a club has no junior sides aligned subject to reasons outside of its control, therefore slowing the pathway to senior participation.</li> </ul>

<b>COMPETITIONS WITH AN EXISTING PPIS</b>	In competitions where a PPIS already exists incumbent IMPACT TRANSFER players who are in their second, third or fourth year with the same club can be assessed at a discounted rate. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>In situations where a player has local player status and <u>has registered</u> with their club for the upcoming season and that club is subsequently unable to field a team in that grade.</li> <li>Any person not registered with the subject club or another club in the same League's immediate past season who is contracted as 1st Grade Marquee Player/Coach by a Club which did not qualify for the 1st Grade semi-finals in the immediate past season shall be assessed as zero points for PPIS purposes in their initial season as Marquee Player/Coach and for each consecutive season they register with such club thereafter.</li> </ul>	0	0	0

A Marquee player is a player whose current Points Allocation is above the level of the competition which he is relocating i.e. category C, D or E player moving into a category B competition.
